# QUICK GUIDE: THE ROYAL COLLEGE MOC PROGRAM AND FRAMEWORK



- 250 credits per five-year cycle
- A minimum of 25 credits per year
- A minimum of 25 credits for Section 3 per five-year cycle, which must include one (1) "Feedback Received" activity.
- There are no longer any minimum requirements for Section 1 and Section 2

Section 1: Group Learning Knowledge, skills and abilities acquired through group or team learning activities, including collaborative interprofessional and patient partner activities. Activities must be interactive through opportunities for discussion and can be in-person or virtual.
